This week:

- We learned about Thomas this week during Jesus Time. He didn't believe Jesus was alive until he
 saw Jesus with his own eyes, touched Him, and heard Jesus' words. We thank the Lord for the

The students watched a slideshow from a previous year's Authors' Tea. It was fun to see examples of the stories that other year's students wrote. We looked at the photos of the celebration in the gym and everyone can't wait to sign their autographs at the book tables. There will be special refreshments to share with guests. The students got a great start on the first books that will be displayed at the book tables for everyone to see. They worked very hard this week. Next week we will continue making stories to share. By Friday, May 4, we hope to have one story picked out for each child that will be read to everyone. Check the Friday Folder that weekend and help your child to practice reading the story with good expression and volume. We can't wait for all of you to come to our Authors' Tea! I will also need help setting up the gym on Thursday, May 17 after school. If you can help, please email me.
