Special Activities this Week:

- ★learned how God not only created us, but is with us daily. They learned how special it is to be with Him in prayer, in church and in His Word. God's love is so great that after sin separated us, Jesus came to us and brought salvation.
- ★ wrote in their journals about how they would like to travel or a trip they would like to take.
- ★ practiced printing Tt and looked for words that start with t in the picture dictionary.
- ★ drew pictures of their teeth in their ABC journal and recorded the quantity lost.
- ★ listened to some books about transportation.
- ★ made a book called **Go Up**. This book helps students to learn the sight words "go" and "up" as well as some color words.
- ★ had fun singing the words in a book called <u>Color Train</u> which also helped them learn to read color words. We used this book in class as we pointed to the words and sang.

As we used this book I noticed that a few children have difficulty turning one page at a time. Provide opportunities for your child to sit with you and read together. Help them learn to use the pointer and thumb to turn pages by the corner. Also I noticed that some students do not realize that the left page goes first and that words go from top to bottom, left to right. Read often together with your children at home. Watch as your child points to the words and tracks print.

- ★ made boats out of foil. They experimented with one to see how much cargo it could hold before it sank. They had fun making a hypothesis about to predict what it would take to sink the boat. A worksheet gave them practice making tally marks to record their results.
- ★ made a book called <u>I Can Travel</u>. This predictable emergent reader book gave the students exposure to the sentence frame "I can travel..." It also helped them to think about different modes of transportation on land, sea, and in the air. They had fun being creative as they decorated the pages. They also had to learn to follow a model and think about the sequence and steps to follow in order to complete the book.
- ★ played a Bingo game to reinforce number concepts.
- ★ read a book called On the Go and discussed many methods of transportation around the world. Then each child chose one way we can travel. We printed out each child's sentence and showed it on the computer screen so that everyone could see. Throughout the process the kids were learning so many things: sight words, left-to-right progression, words are separated by spaces, words put together make a sentence, etc. Next week each child will cut their sentence apart and find the spaces between the words. Then they will mix the words up and reconstruct the sentence. They will glue their sentences on car-shaped pages. These will be on display sometime next week and then they will be placed in a book in the big book station where they can read it together.

★ Practice left and right with your child (left hand, right hand as well as right side of a paper, or turn

to the left, etc.) Also, please help your child learn to put on his/her shoes, socks, and clothing independently.

★ Review both the uppercase and lowercase letters with your child.

Help him/her to recognize them out of order. Talk about their sounds. **Practice printing them.**

★ Help your child to hold a pencil correctly. Only the pointer finger should be on top of the pencil.
