This week:

- Thanks to God for the gift of faith! We learned how God works faith in our hearts through His Word and through baptism as we learned about event with Philip and the Ethiopian in the Bible. The kids had fun making little scrolls on Friday.
- Our trip to the post office was a great learning experience! Thanks to the drivers!
- Students worked on some zoo thematic centers this week. They found the zoo tangram puzzles quite challenging! They help students work on problem-solving as well as spatial relationships. The students also played a game called "I See 20". They had to choose 2 or 3 animal numbers and find combinations that equal 20. Some also played a similar game called "I See 10" and made combinations to equal 10.
- We also made an additional sight word book called <u>A Ride to the Zoo</u>. They learned another word that practices a long vowel pattern using "silent e" ride. They have now learned all of the sight words for the year. Please practice the words on the homework section with your child. I will retest students next week. If your child did not master the words from the first two trimesters, please practice those with your child as well. These words are very important to help your child read well in first grade.
- The students have been learning how to solve and illustrate story problems in Math. They have also been learning how to write fact families.
- We worked very hard all week to practice reading our Authors' Tea stories. Please help your child practice the story at home as well. The stories were sent home last week. Please help your child to read it well in a loud voice and to use good expression. Next week we will continue to practice reading our stories as we speak into a microphone. Your child should still arrive at school no later than 8:30a.m. and the program will begin at 9:00a.m. in the sanctuary. Following the book presentations we will go to the gym for book signing opportunities and refreshments. I hope that you will enjoy our Authors' Tea. Students should wear clothing appropriate for church to the Authors' Tea. They may bring a change of clothes for the afternoon. Girls typically wear dresses and the boys wear a shirt with a collar. (church clothes)

- Next week I will conduct a variety of end of the year assessments for report cards. Please make sure your child gets enough rest and eats a good breakfast.
